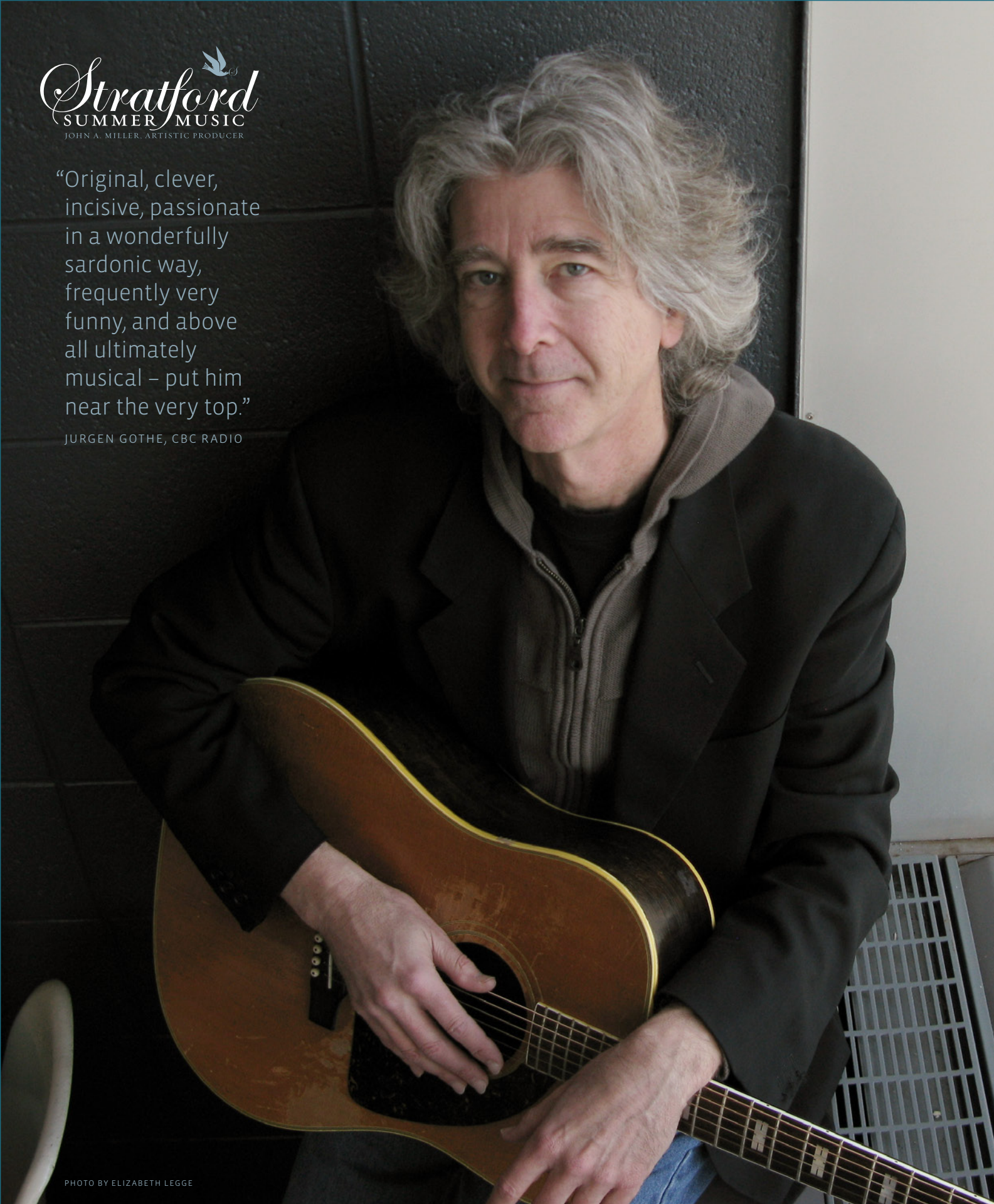

George Meanwell: Songs of Travel

George Meanwell is a musician and songwriter who has been performing for forty years. He began as a guitarist in the acoustic folk trio *SHORT TURN*, and after a number of years as an orchestral cellist in Canada and England he was founding cellist, guitarist and mandolinist of the acclaimed *QUARTETTO GELATO* (NPR's Debut Artist of the Year 1993), performing throughout North America, Europe and Asia. In 2002 he returned to song writing, releasing *Another Street* (CBC's *Disc Drive* 2003 year-end hit list) and *Late* in 2008. Meanwell has been on stage at the Stratford Shakespeare Festival for the past two seasons.

Songs of Travel is a six-part tour through Meanwell's diverse and surprising catalogue, interspersed with wry commentary and punctuated by the occasional unlikely instrumental.
